Mode of payment of fees:-

Parents -Teachers Meeting:-

The school organizes Parents-Teachers meeting from time to time to promote communication for the development to students. Besides these meeting they are always welcome to the school office to discuss the development of the ward/wards.

Holidays:-

The school provides a list of Holidays for each academic year as per the guidelines laid down by C.B.S.E.

Admission Procedure:-

Students seeking admission to our school will have to go through admission test conducted by our admission department. Student must get themselves registered in the school for appearing in the admission test. For this delay should conduct the admission deptt.

Discipline:-

Special attention is given to ensure a high standard of moral values and discipline in the school. Parents and guardians are requested to collaborate in this with the authorities of the school by ensuring regular attendance and punctuality of their ward/wards and strict adherence to the rule of school.

Examination procedure :-

The school conducts three terminal Examinations besides monthly test of all subjects are held. All examinations and tests are compulsory promotion and grade of any student to the next class is decided on the basis of his/her performance of the monthly tests and all examinations of the academic year.

Withdrawal procedure :-

- (a) One month's notice for the withdrawal of your ward is necessary.
- (b) Those who fail to show satisfactory progress and regular Absence from the school proper notice will be liable to have his/her name struck of the roll, admission may be granted on payment of fresh admission fee.
- (c) Those who fail twice in the same class and are below average will have to leave the school.
- (d) Transfer or withdrawal request will not be entertained until all dues are paid.

Important suggestions to guardians :-

- (a) Parents are requested to check the diary and read the remarks given by the teachers.
- (b) Parents/Guardians/Visitors are not allowed to visit the classes and talk to the teachers or students during class hours without permission of the principal.
- (c) Parents/Guardians should attend parents-teachers as and when organised by the school. This will have an extra edge on the student's performance.
- (d) Parents may meet the principal at the stipulated time to discuss the matters concerning the progress of their respective wards.
- (e) Parents/Guardians are requested to examine the progress report carefully and pay additional attention to see that children make special efforts to study those subjects in which they are weak.
- (f) Parents are advised to keep balance between responsibility, forgiveness and love for children.
- (g) Children of a teacher must be avoided in the presence of the child because it under-mines respect for the teachers and the school.
- (h) Should you have a legitimate complaint please feel free to meet the principle on any working day.
- (i) Encourage your child to participate in all activities of the school.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Students are required to arrive at school 10 minutes before the reporting time in proper school uniform.

Students are required to be friendly with others in and outside the school.

Students should avoid vulgarity in talk and behavior.

Students suffering from infectious disease should not come to attend classes until completely cured.

No student will be allowed to wear jewellery or ornaments in the school.

The bill must be given on fifth day of the month. Payment must be made within a week from the date of the bill. Rs. 100/- as a default on remittance after the month due.

No student will be allowed to go home without the written permission of the principal unless the parent or an authorized guardian comes to receive him/her.

Students are strictly prohibited to bring crackers, colours, transistor, mobile phones etc. inside the school campus. These activities will amount to the expulsion of students from the school.

Any damage to school property should immediately be reported to the principal or a teacher.

Students should be obedient polite and should show respect to their teachers.
